

Resolution No. 2014-19
A Resolution Appointing an AIA Architect to the Historic Area Commission

WHEREAS, the New Castle City Code provides that City Council shall appoint an architect holding membership in the American Institute of Architects and having interest and knowledge in the protection, preservation and restoration of the colonial aspects of the city to the Historic Area Commission for a term of three years; and

WHEREAS, the current Historic Area Commission appointed Architect, Douglas Heckrotte's term has expired; and

WHEREAS, Leila Hamroun, in addition to holding membership in the American Institute of Architects has twenty-five years of national and international heritage preservation experience; and

WHEREAS, the City Council proposes to appoint Leila Hamroun as the City Council's selection as the Historic Area Commission; for a three year term, with that term ending on April 18, 2017.
