Separation Day Resident Entry Permit Information

The City will make available a temporary residential entry permit for the Separation Day Weekend for residents who live in the areas of the City where traffic will be "blocked off" for events during the weekend.

Please note: The Entry Permit **will not guarantee you a parking place**, but will allow you entry so that you can get to your home.

Resident participation will be **voluntary**, and will enable the police officers, police volunteers and fire police to better enforce traffic into the town and still let residents get through to their homes.
