

Resolution No. 2016-35

A Resolution calling for Council Approval on any City spending over \$10,000 dollars in reference to the awarding bids, contracts for city services, capital expenditures, repairs or improvements.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of New Castle has determined that expenditures in excess of \$10,000 should require advance Council approval as it relates to awarding bids or contracts involving city services, capital expenditures, repairs or improvements, but not including payroll administration and other routine, reoccurring expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of The City of New Castle that contracts for city services, capital expenditures, acquisitions, repairs or improvements involving the expenditure of City funds in excess of \$10,000 shall require an affirmative vote from a majority of Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that prior to a motion to obtain Council approval for such expenditures in excess of \$10,000, an informative description of the proposed project, repair, acquisition or other service must be presented to Council, which description shall include background information, including all quotes, bids or cost estimates, an estimate of the completion date (if applicable), and the objective(s) of the project.
