CAMP FORMAT:

Battery Park Half Day Camp runs from 8:30am-12:30pm, Monday through Thursday only.

ACTIVITIES:

This is an outdoor camp. Campers will need to arrive with sunscreen applied and appropriate clothing and sneakers. In case of extreme inclement weather, campers will seek shelter in the New Castle Presbyterian Church located on 25 E 2nd St, New Castle, DE 19720

LATE PICKUP: A late pickup fee of \$15 will be charged for each child picked up after the program closes (12:30 pm). An additional \$15 fee is charged for each 15-minute interval, or part thereof, as we do not prorate this fee by the minute. Parents/guardians that arrive late will be asked to sign a late pickup form and it is the responsibility of the parent to submit the late pickup fee at time of pick up.
