Code Enforcement Report: Mosquito Control

The City of New Castle will be cooperating with the State of Delaware Division of Fish & Wildlife to

maximize mosquito control in the area in an effort to combat mosquito borne diseases.

The City will aggressively enforce City

health codes that require the elimination of standing water, and encourages residents to report problems.

Look for potential areas for mosquito breeding, such as tires, buckets or tubs, boat tarps, clogged rain gutters, tree rot hole or hollow stump, anywhere water can collect and stagnate.

Pre-registration is required. Payment is due in full at time of registration. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Space is limited.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH:

CAMP FORMAT:

Half Day Camps run from 8:30am-12:30pm, Monday through Thursday

ACTIVITIES:

Daily camp programming includes arts/crafts, weekly themes, fitness and nature activities, sports games, fresh-air time, and recreational & educational programming.

LATE PICKUP:

A late pickup fee of \$15 will be charged for each child picked up after the program closes (4pm or 5:30pm for after-care). An additional \$15 fee is charged for each 15-minute interval, or part thereof, as we do not prorate this fee by the minute. Parents/guardians that arrive late will be asked to sign a late pickup form and payment is due at time of pickup. Child cannot return to camp until the late pickup fee is paid.
