PUBLIC POWER RELIABILITY

Know your property and house and take appropriate action to prevent damages.



Have a plan in case of a power outage or evacuation.



Create an evacuation and emergency supply kit.

CREATE A SUPPLY KIT

- Radio - Battery operated/ NOAA Weather Radio
- Flashlight/Batteries/Tools
- Water - at least 1 gallon daily per person for 3 days
- Food - at least 3 days worth of non-perishable packaged or canned food/juices, food for infants, snacks, non-electric can opener, cooking tools, fuel/matches/lighter, grill, paper plates, plastic utensils
- Filled gas container
- First aid kit/Medicines
- Clothing
- Blankets/Pillows
- Toiletries
- Cash/Keys/Important Documents
- Infant/Elderly/Pet Care supplies
- Toys/Books
