

Resolution 2017-29

A Resolution to Require Proposed Appointees to City Boards, Commissions, Committees or other City Offices to Appear before City Council at time of Appointment

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of New Castle is responsible for confirming the appointment of proposed members to various City Boards, Commissions, Committees or other City offices, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is desirable to interview prospective appointees prior to voting on confirmation of their appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of New Castle, that it shall be a condition of their appointment that all proposed appointees to City Boards, Commissions or Committees, including Council appointments to City Council or the position of Mayor in cases where Council must fill a vacancy, must appear in person before City Council at the time set for voting on their confirmation to make themselves available for questions relating to their qualifications and suitability for the appointment.
