A Resolution to Establish a Task Force to Develop and Propose a Formal Code of Ethics For Elected Officials and Non-Union Employees in the City Of New Castle

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of New Castle wishes to consider the adoption of a formal Code of Ethics as to the conduct of elected officials and non-union employees in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish a temporary committee to study, develop and propose a Code of Ethics for Council’s consideration and adoption as an amendment to the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of New Castle, that the following individuals are hereby appointed to a temporary committee to be known as the Ethics Committee, which committee is charged with meeting, studying, developing and proposing to City Council a comprehensive Code of Ethics for consideration and adoption as an amendment to the City Code:
