

Resolution No. 2018-12

A Resolution to Confirm Road and Drainage Projects to begin in the Spring of 2018

WHEREAS, in November, 2017, the City Council was given a presentation by the City Engineer and Building Official recommending road and drainage projects need to be completed in the upcoming construction cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City Council had instructed the City Administrator and Staff to put together a bid package that included the project recommendations by the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the City Engineer, City Solicitor, Building Official and City Administrator, such a bid package was produced, and a bid was let; and

WHEREAS, the projects bid were: a base bid for the sum on work at two locations- Baldt Avenue pavement restoration and drainage repair and replacement on Third Street. Bids were also sought for projects at four locations as alternates: Baldt Avenue widening, Centerpoint Boulevard, Johnson Way, and Grey Street; and

WHEREAS, the advertising of such bid produced a response from four qualified bidders, with the lowest aggregate bid for all projects being from Cirillo Brothers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council can decide which of these projects they wish to complete, or not, within the current construction period.

RESOLVED, THEREFORE, that the City Administrator is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Cirillo Brothers Paving, pursuant to their bid and the associated technical and administrative specifications provided during the bidding process **based on a unit cost bid and for the quantities estimated by the City Engineer** for the following projects:

1. The Base bid for Baldt Avenue work as described in the amount of \$206,055.80 and the Third Street work as described in the amount of \$119,429.00, for a total amount of \$325,484.80;
2. For the alternate bid for the Baldt Avenue widening project, increasing the base bid by the amount of \$169,821.00 (in addition of the base bid of \$206,055.80 for Baldt Ave. pavement restoration);
3. For the alternate bid for Centerpoint Boulevard as described in the amount of \$303,325.00;
4. For the alternate bid for the Johnson Way work as described in the amount of \$89,187.00;
5. For the alternate bid for the Gray Street work as described in the amount of \$106,124.10
