

**Resolution 2018-14**

**A Resolution Approving Placement of a Handicapped Parking Space  
at 632 Delaware Street in Front of Wallace Hair Salon**

**WHEREAS**, the City has received a request from Wallace Hair Salon for the installation of a Handicapped Parking Space in front of the establishment located at 632 Delaware Street for the use of qualified patrons and others visiting said businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Code provides that a handicapped space may be installed by the City on a public street in front of a residential property, upon the request of a resident and proof that a person living at the property has been issued a permit for handicapped parking; and

**WHEREAS**, although there is no provision in the City Code for the City to designate on a public street a handicapped parking space where a business is located, the City Council has approved requests for such spaces to accommodate a business use nonetheless.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby approves the request from Wallace Hair Salon for the City to install a Handicapped Parking Space in front of said business located at 632 Delaware Street, for the use of qualified patrons and others visiting the area.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the aforementioned space, is on public property, and is not a personal parking space, and can be utilized by any vehicle displaying a vehicle registration plate stating the word “Handicapped” or other form of disabled person’s parking permit, such as a windshield placard.
