

Ordinance No. 524

An Ordinance to amend Section 230-50 A (1) (c) of the Code of the City of New Castle to require Council confirmation of Mayoral appointments to the Historic Area Commission.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of New Castle desires to make certain amendments to Section 230-50 A (1) (c) of the City Code relating to Mayoral appointments to the Historic Area Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of New Castle, the following:

SECTION 1: Section 230-50 A (1) (c) of the Code of the City of New Castle is hereby amended as follows (new language underlined):

§ 230-50 Creation of Historic Area Commission.

A. Creation.

(1) Historic Area Commission is hereby created. The Commission shall consist of the following six members:

(c) Two City residents having municipal voting privileges, appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council of New Castle.

SECTION 2: The remaining provisions of §230-50 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. In the event any existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances are in conflict herewith, the provisions of this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
