MSC to host Information Session on PFAS Exposure Assessment

Monday, August 26th 5:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. New Castle Historical Society 30 Market Street, New Castle 5:30–6:00 p.m. "Meet and greet" with staff from CDC/ATSDR, state and local agencies and local stakeholders. 6:00–8:00 p.m. Presentation on the PFAS exposure assessment, followed by questions and discussion.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) is conducting an exposure assessment for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in New Castle County near New Castle Air National Guard Base. CDC/ATSDR is holding an information session to answer questions from the community, listen to concerns, and promote transparency and

understanding. Everyone is invited to attend.

PFAS will perform exposure assessments in our community.

- 1. CDC/ATSDR staff will meet with community members and answer questions about the exposure assessments.
- 2. Households will be randomly selected
- 3. Participants will provide blood and urine samples as well as environmental samples from their homes.
- 4. Samples will be analyzed and results will be sent to participants.
- 5. CDC/ATSDR will review results and write a report.
- 6. CDC/ATSDR staff will host another community event to discuss results.

Code Enforcement Corner

Garbage, Yard Waste & Recycle § 204-6 Rules and regulations governing disposition and collection of garbage, and refuse.



Place trash, yard waste and recycle at the curb the <u>night before vour</u> scheduled pick-up day, this will insure vour items will be picked up. Public Works crews start work at 6 a.m. in the

summer, and 7 a.m. in the fall and winter.

TRASH/RECYCLE & YARD WASTE:

Trash and trash containers: All garbage is to be secured in plastic bags and placed inside solid containers (metal or plastic), with lids securely in place, each residence may place up to four (4) 35 gallon/50 pounds maximum at the curb for pick-up.

Removal of Trash Containers: All containers must be electronic recycle at no cost. If you need a recycle removed from the sidewalk or roadway

and stored on the same day that they are picked up. Containers shall be placed or stored in the rear of residential dwellings, or along the side vards or alleyways but not within five feet of the front of the dwelling unless concealed by a fence.



YARD WASTE: Yard waste including branches, tree trimmings, sticks, grass clippings are collected on

Wednesdays. Containers or plastic bags do not need to be used for yard waste. Such refuse may be securely tied together in bundles, each of which shall not exceed 50 pounds in weight or four feet in length. Grass clippings and other garden refuse can be bagged not to exceed 50 pounds in weight.

RECYCLE: Placement and removal times for your



recycle container is the same as for normal trash. Please place unbagged recycle items in a container, if you are unsure of what is recyclable please call Delaware Solid Waste Authority at 800-404-7080 or visit their website at www.DSWA.com. DSWA also

offers hazardous waste disposal, paper shredding and container call the city office at 322-9801.

SPECIAL TRASH PICK-UP: A special trash pick-up can be arranged by going on the City website or calling the City Administration Building at 322-9801.
