PFAS Exposure Assessment New Castle County, Delaware near New Castle Air National Guard Base





DID YOU RECEIVE A LETTER? Please call the number on your letter to let us know if you are interested in participating or not.

PEAS chemicals were found in drinking water in New Castle County, Delaware near New Castle Air National Guard Base. They are no longer found at levels above the EPA health advisory.

The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) is offering free, voluntary blood and urine testing for PFAS to a random selection of households who had PFAS in their drinking water.

If your household is selected, you will receive a letter in the mail. Please call the number on the letter. If we do not hear from you, we will call you or visit your house if we cannot reach you by phone.

This exposure assessment will help participants and their community better understand their exposure to PFAS.
