Notice is hereby given by the Board of Elections of the City of New Castle that an Election will be held on April 10, 2020 for the following offices:

<u>OFFICE</u>	<u>YEARLY SALARY</u>	<u>TERM</u>
<b>City Council President</b>	\$3,750	4 Years
<b>Councilpersons</b> Two Seats	\$3,150	4 Years

**To run for President or Member of the City Council** you must be a citizen of the State of Delaware and a resident of the City of New Castle and have resided in the City for two years before the election and at the time of the election must be a qualified voter of the City.

**In order to file your candidacy for election you must:**

Complete a Candidate Filing form, available at the City Administration office, 220 Delaware Street, during regular business hours - 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. by the deadline set forth below.

**Important Dates:**

**January 4th** First day to file to run for office

**February 26th** Last day to file to run for office (5 p.m.)

**March 3rd** First day to file to receive an Absentee Ballot and to Vote Absentee

Applications for Absentee Ballots will be available from the City Office from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. beginning Wednesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, and on the City website at [www.newcastlecity.delaware.gov/elections](http://www.newcastlecity.delaware.gov/elections).

**March 20th** Last day to file to withdraw as a candidate running for office

**April 5th** Last day to register to vote with the State of Delaware Department of Elections.

**April 9th** **12:00 Noon** is the deadline to request an affidavit for Absentee Ballot from the City Administration office, 220 Delaware Street.

**April 9th** **4:30 p.m.** is the deadline for Absentee Ballots to be turned in to the City Office. Absentee Ballots may also be brought to the polling place on the day of the Election.

**April 10th** **City Election Day** Voting will take place at the New Castle Senior Center, 400 South Street, New Castle, DE 19720 - 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

**April 12th** **Canvass of Votes:** 8:00 p.m.
