

RESOLUTION 2021-33

A Resolution to Revise Existing Handicapped Parking Regulations at the City Parking Lot Located at Ferry Cutoff and Delaware Street and to Approve the Installation of Electric Charging Facilities

WHEREAS, the public parking lot owned by the City of New Castle (the “City”) at the intersection of Ferry Cutoff and Delaware Street currently includes two parking spaces reserved for handicapped parking; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the growing use of electric powered motor vehicles in the City and desires to increase the number of electric charging stations in the City available to the public

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council that, effective immediately, the number of parking spaces reserved for handicapped persons at the public parking lot the intersection of Ferry Cutoff and Delaware Street (the “Parking Lot”) shall be _____; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council approves the installation of _____ electric vehicle charging station(s) at the Parking Lot which shall be generally available for public use; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to implement the foregoing resolutions.
