

Resolution 2022-33

**A Resolution to Approve Handicapped Parking Spot on E. Fourth Street
behind 136 E. Third Street**

WHEREAS, a resident at 136 E. Third Street, who is disabled under the definition provided in section 172-7 of the City Code has requested that the City install a handicapped parking space in back of their house on Fourth Street; and

WHEREAS, a handicapped parking space will allow the disabled resident to enter their house through the back of their residence, a fire hydrant is located on Third Street in front of said residence allowing no parking; and

WHEREAS, Section 172-9 of the City Code provides that a handicapped parking space on a public street may not be designated as reserved for a disabled resident's exclusive use if said resident has off-street parking available; and

WHEREAS, City Council supports the public policy of making reasonable and appropriate accommodations for disabled persons and acknowledges that parking on public rights of way must be evaluated on a case by case basis considering the facts and circumstances affecting public safety and convenience unique to each case.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City Council approves the request from the disabled resident at 136 E. Third Street to install a handicapped parking space in back of said residence on Fourth Street, which handicapped parking space shall be generally available for the use of any persons deemed disabled pursuant to the provisions of Section 172-7 of the City Code.
