Affidavits for Absentee Ballots will be available from the City Office, during normal business hours, Monday - Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. beginning July 10th.

Added dates and times when Affidavits for Absentee Ballots and State Voter Registration will be available from the City Office are: Saturday, July 15th from 9 a.m. to 12 noon and Tuesday, July 18th from 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. *State Voter Registration is available at the City Office during normal business hours; the deadline to register to vote in the Election is Monday, July 31st.

August 4th at 12 noon is the deadline to request an affidavit for Absentee Ballots from the City Administration office, 220 Delaware Street and to return voted Absentee Ballots.

Absentee Ballots may also be brought to the polling place on the day of the Election.

Qualifications to Vote in the Election (from the New Castle City Charter)

At any municipal election of the City of New Castle all individuals who shall have attained the age of eighteen 18 at the time of the election who shall have been a resident of the City of New Castle for thirty 30 days preceding said election shall be entitled to vote provided however that said person is otherwise qualified to register to vote *and has registered to vote as required by the Election Laws of the State of Delaware 15 Del C Chapter 75 five 5 days prior to said election. The Board of Elections shall decide on the legality of the votes offered.
