

**Resolution 2023-21**

**A Resolution to Approve Handicapped Parking Spot on 172 E. Fourth Street  
in front of house**

**WHEREAS**, a resident at 172 E. Fourth Street, who is disabled under the definition provided in section 172-7 of the City Code has requested that the City install a handicapped parking space in front of their residence; and

**WHEREAS**, Resident has a driveway, but it is more than 200 feet to get to their front door and

**WHEREAS**, a handicapped parking space will allow the disabled resident to enter their house through the front of the residence; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 172-9 of the City Code provides that a handicapped parking space on a public street may not be designated as reserved for a disabled resident's exclusive use if said resident has off-street parking available; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council supports the public policy of making reasonable and appropriate accommodations for disabled persons and acknowledges that parking on public rights of way must be evaluated on a case by case basis considering the facts and circumstances affecting public safety and convenience unique to each case.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the City Council approves the request from the disabled resident at 172 E Fourth Street to install a handicapped parking space in front of said residence on Fourth Street, which handicapped parking space shall be generally available for the use of any persons deemed disabled pursuant to the provisions of Section 172-7 of the City Code.
