



NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF CANDIDATES

Notice is hereby given by the Board of Elections of the City of New Castle that a Special Election will be held on November 4, 2023 for the following offices:

<u>OFFICE</u>	<u>YEARLY SALARY</u>	<u>TERM</u>
Council President	\$3,750	Remainder of 4 Year Term
Member of Council	\$3,150	Remainder of 4 Year Term

To run for President or Member of Council you must be a citizen of the State of Delaware and a resident of the City of New Castle, have resided in the City for two years before the election and at the time of the election must be a qualified voter of the City, and satisfy the requirements of Title 15, Section 7555 of the Delaware Code.

In order to file your candidacy for election you must:

Complete a Candidate Filing form, available at the City Administration office, 220 Delaware Street, during regular business hours - 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. by the deadline set forth below. Forms may only be picked up and filed by the person wishing to file for candidacy. **At the time of filing**, the candidate must provide proof of residency.

Important Dates:

September 5th First day to file to run for office

September 25th Last day to file to run for office (**5 p.m.**)

October 9th First day to file to receive an Absentee Ballot and to Vote Absentee

Applications for Absentee Ballots will be available from the City Office from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. beginning Monday, October 9th.

October 13th Last day to file to withdraw as a candidate running for office

October 30th Last day to register to vote with the State of Delaware Department of Elections.

November 3rd **12:00 Noon** is the deadline to request an Absentee Ballot or turn in a voted Absentee Ballot at the City Administration office, 220 Delaware Street. Absentee Ballots may also be brought to the polling place on the day of the Election.

November 4th **City Election Day** Voting will take place at the Good Will Fire Company, 401 South Street, New Castle, DE 19720 - 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

November 6th **Canvass of Votes**: 8:00 p.m.
