New U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) final guidance has established a blood donor screening process based on individual donor assessment, not sexual or gender identity.

This means that men who have sex with men are no longer automatically deferred from donating blood. Instead, every donor undertakes the same assessment to determine elligibility.

Eligibility criteria

So what does it take to be a blood donor? If you feel healthy and well, you may be eligible! Blood donors must be:

- 17 years or older 16 with written parental permission/consent
- Weigh at least 110 pounds
- Symptom-free for at least 72 hours following a cold or flu
- Have not donated blood within the last 8 weeks

Every 2 seconds someone needs blood



The average adult has about 10.5 pints of blood in their body

62% of the U.S. is eligible to donate blood, yet only about **3% do**



More than 25% of the blood supply is used by cancer patients



1 out of 3 people will need blood in their lifetime

More than 15 million units of blood products are transfused in the U.S. every year
