When is Delaware's General Election?

- Delaware's 2024 General Election is Tuesday, November 5, 2024.
- General Election Early Voting Dates & Times:
 - October 25, 2024 October 29, 2024, 11:00a.m. 7:00p.m.
 - October 30, 2024 November
 3, 2024, 7:00a.m. 7:00p.m
- Polling Places are open from 7:00a.m. until 8:00p.m. on General Election Day, November 5, 2024.
- Delaware's General Election is on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

Who can vote in a General Election?

• All eligible Delaware voters may vote in the General Election.

What are the three options to vote in Delaware?

Voters have the following three options for voting in Delaware:

- Absentee Voting (if you are eligible, includes permanent absentee voting)
- Early Voting
- Election Day Voting

Trustee Community Grant Program

The Trustees of the New Castle Common have posted the 2025-2026 Grant Application on their Website: www.trusteesncc.org.

Organizations within the town of New Castle can apply for grants. The Trustees mission is to manage its resources "for the benefit of the citizens of New Castle." Citizens are defined as the residents of the incorporated area of the City.

If an organization has activities both inside and outside of the New Castle City limits, the Trustees can only support those activities within the City. Information and documentation provided must clearly indicate the location of services provided.

Remember! Your organization must complete and return the "Grant Request Application" to the Trustees of the New Castle Common by December 31, 2024.

Trustees Scholarship Fund Applications for Spring 2025 are Available Now



The "Trustees of New Castle Common Scholarship Fund" was established in 1983 for eligible residents of the City of New Castle.

The scholarships are awarded to full-time residents of the City of New Castle and are for undergraduate study only. Applicants must provide an acceptance letter from a college or university to be considered for the scholarship. If the applicant is a dependent, the parent must be a resident of the City of New Castle. A copy of an MSC bill is required as proof of residency.

A new applicant must be a high school graduate who is entering an accredited undergraduate college or university as a full-time student in the coming Spring 2025 semester. The application deadline is January 2, 2025.

Fall 2024 scholarship recipients only need to provide an official Fall 2024 grade transcript prior to the January 2, 2025 deadline. Current recipients do not need to provide any other information at this time.

Completed packets can be returned online to office@trusteesncc.org or by mail to Trustees of New Castle Commons, 807 Frenchtown Road, New Castle, DE 19720. Completed applications can also be hand delivered to the same address Monday – Thursday, 10 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.
