

The ordering period for the Subsidized Rain barrels has been extended and the new pickup date is July 17th, 2026. Please place your orders before then. Those who have already placed orders should have been contacted by phone and email with updates regarding the pickup.

As presented by the City of New Castle City Council and the City of New Castle Flood Resiliency Committee, the City is coordinating with RainBarrel.ca to bring Rain Barrels to the City of New Castle. Rain Barrels are offered at a subsidized rate as supported by funding from The City Of New Castle and The Trustees of the New Castle Common.
